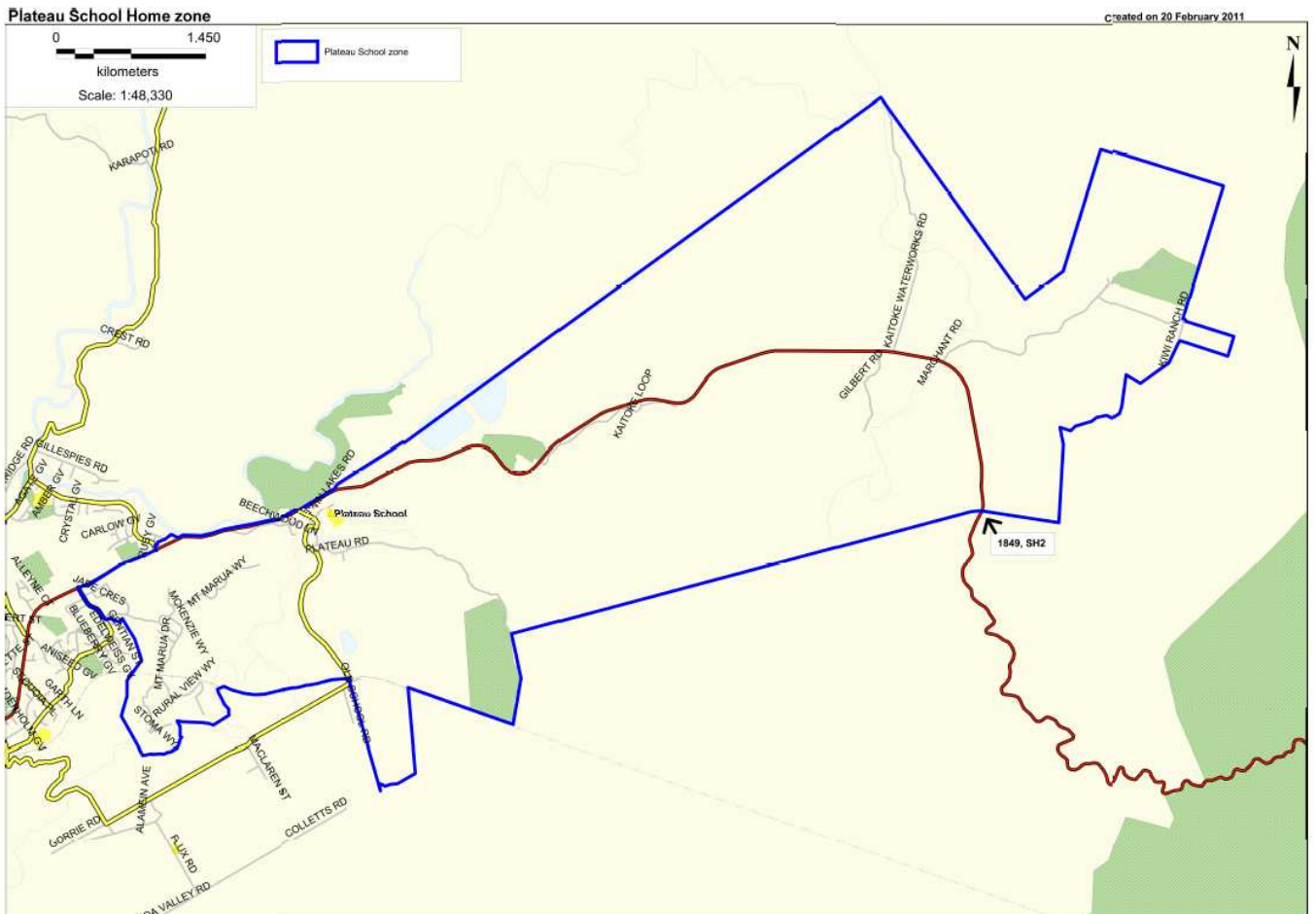


# PLATEAU SCHOOL ENROLMENT SCHEME

## Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone as **shown on the attached map**, and as per the description below shall be entitled to enrol at Plateau School.



**Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.**

## PLATEAU SCHOOL ENROLMENT SCHEME

### HOME ZONE

All students who live within the home zone described below and shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The northern most point of the zone is located at the end of Kaitoke Waterworks Road. To the east, the home zone includes both sides of the Kiwi Ranch Road.

Continuing in a south westerly direction, the zone boundary is a line from the end of Kiwi Ranch Road to number 1849 on State Highway 2 and then continuing west such that Plateau Road is in zone and the zone boundary meets the railway line.

The zone boundary then includes a U shape, of 3 large land parcels to the east of School Road. School Road is not in zone.

From the intersection of Maymorn Road and Parkes Line Road the zone boundary continues west by following the railway line until it passes over the stream and the boundary then follows the stream such that all of the Rural View Way and Stroma Way are included in zone.

From the end of Stroma Way the boundary goes north to the intersection of Mt Marua Drive and Norana Road. Mt Marua Drive and Mt Marua Way and off-streets are in zone. Gentian Street and Snowberry Grove are not in zone.

From the intersection of Mount Marua Drive and Norana Road the zone boundary is north to include the east side of the Norana Road (street number 126 and above) to the intersection of Norana Road and Main Road North (State Highway 2).

From the intersection of Norana Road and SH 2 the boundary is east along SH 2 to include Twin Lakes Road. From the northern end of Twin Lakes Road the zone boundary is a straight line to the northern end of Kaitoke Waterworks Road.

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students may be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the Board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

### OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS

Each year the Board will determine the number of places, if any, which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. If there are places, the Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

#### **Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:**

First Priority	This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.
Second Priority	will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
Third Priority	will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
Fourth priority	will be given to applicants who are children of former students.
Fifth priority	will be given to applicants who are either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
Sixth priority	will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.

Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
